II. Here at Frontline Events LTD we are committed to protecting your privacy and maintaining the security your personal information. We strictly adhere to the requirements of the The Data Protection Act 2018.

The purpose of this statement is to explain to you what personal information we collect and how we may use it.

III. How do we collect your personal information? And how do we use it?

When you book an event ticket, meal ticket or any other product, we need to know your name, address, email address and payment option. This allows us to process and fulfil your order. You have the option to withhold personal information that is not required for the order process. We request a contact number as some carriers will not provide a service unless a telephone number is provided for a contact at the destination address.

IV. We use your personal information to notify you of your purchase and to request additional information such as your Valid Defence, under the Violent Crime Reduction Act 2006, or to send you order updates. We will not attempt to contact you sell extra services or products.

V. We do not sell, rent, or exchange your personal information with any third party for commercial reasons, beyond the essential requirement for payment detail validation during purchase, to arrange delivery of your order and to keep you informed of our products and services if you have elected to receive these notifications. We must share your information with the Parcel Force, the courier of your order, so that it can be delivered. We only share your information if necessary. Third parties are also subject to data protection legislation, and we will be happy to direct you to their policies upon request.

We may need to share your details with the Police should the occasion arise. The UK GDPR does not prevent you sharing personal data with law enforcement authorities (known under data protection law as “competent authorities”) who are discharging their statutory law enforcement functions. The UK GDPR and the DPA 2018 allow for this type of data sharing where it is necessary and proportionate.

VI. We have strict security procedures in the storage and disclosure of information which you have provided, preventing unauthorised access in accordance with the The Data Protection Act 2018.

We do not collect sensitive information about you except when you specifically knowingly provide it. You can ask us to remove all Data collected by Frontline Events Ltd, it is your 'right to erasure', by e-mailing frontlineww2events@gmail.com.
